

COMPOUND SENTENCE

REMEMBER!

A **compound sentence** consists of **two or more independent clauses** joined by a **coordinating conjunction** (e.g., **and, but, or, so**).

- **Example:** It was raining, **but** they still went to the outdoor show.

- Some verbs are followed by to-infinitives: *agree, decide, expect, hope, plan, promise, want, would like.....*
- Some verbs are followed by bare infinitives (without "to"): *make, let, hear, see, watch, notice, feel.....*
