THE ORIGIN OF PIZZA

Pizza is a popular food that many people enjoy today, but it has a long history. Pizza first became well known in Italy, especially in the city of Naples. Long ago, people in Naples made flat bread and added simple toppings like oil, cheese, and tomatoes.

In the 18th and 19th centuries, pizza was food for poor people because it was cheap and easy to make. Street vendors sold pizza to workers and families. One famous story says that in 1889, a pizza maker in Naples created a special pizza with tomatoes, mozzarella cheese, and basil. These ingredients represent the colors of the Italian flag: red, white, and green. This pizza was made for Queen Margherita, and it became very famous.
