Her work **5** helped (help) many mountain gorillas, but it also **6** made (make) some people angry because they **7** didn't want (not/want) to save the gorillas. Her death **10** didn't stop (not/stop) her good work, it continues today with the Dian Fossey Gorilla Fund International.
