

# CONDITIONALS

## 0 CONDITIONAL

used to talk about general truths and general habits

**If you add one and one, you get two.**

## I CONDITIONAL

used to talk about possible or likely things to happen in the future

**If your parents find out about your lies, you will be grounded for weeks.**

**Unless (=if not) you help me, I won't manage to do it on time.**

## II CONDITIONAL

used to talk about impossible things in the present or unlikely things to happen in the future

**If I won the lottery, I would buy a luxury yacht.**

## III CONDITIONAL

used to speculate about things which refer to the past

**If I hadn't been notoriously late, my boss wouldn't have fired me.**

## MIXED CONDITIONALS

used to refer to different times in two parts of a conditional sentence

**If I were you, I wouldn't have quit the job.**

**If I hadn't crashed the car, my parents wouldn't be mad with me now.**

13. If Melanie ..... (shout) at her employees, they are scared.

15. We would spend every summer in the mountains if we ..... (have) a summer house there.
