

9.1 Narrative Writing Skills (Kompetensi Menulis Narrative Text)

Macro Skills

Narrative Writing (Story Writing)

Requires students to write a complete story by organizing ideas into a clear structure, including orientation, complication, and resolution. Students are expected to develop a logical sequence of events and include characters, setting and plot.

Example: Short stories, legends, fairy tales, myths, and fables.

Creative Writing

(Developing Narrative Text)

Focuses on expressing ideas creatively by developing characters, conflicts, and story endings. Students should be able to use descriptive language, sequence connectors, and appropriate grammar to make the story interesting and easy to understand.

Example: Writing a legend, creating an alternative ending, rewriting a story, or composing a
