

PAST CONTINUOUS + SIMPLE PAST

We often use the **Past Continuous** with the **Simple Past** when a **long action** is interrupted by a **short action**. We use the words **WHILE** or **WHEN** to join the ideas.

WHILE + long action (past continuous): **I was watching TV** (this action was in progress)

WHEN + short action (simple past): **the earthquake started** (this action interrupted)

There are 4 basic combinations:

While	Past Continuous	,	Simple Past
When	Simple Past	,	Past Continuous
	Simple Past	while	Past Continuous
	Past Continuous	when	Simple Past

EXAMPLES:

While I was watching TV, the earthquake started.

When the earthquake started, I was watching TV.

The earthquake started **while** I was watching TV.

I was watching TV **when** the earthquake started.
