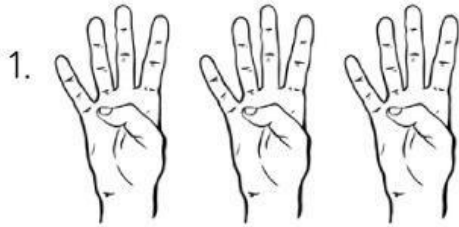


Multiplying by 3, 4 and 8
