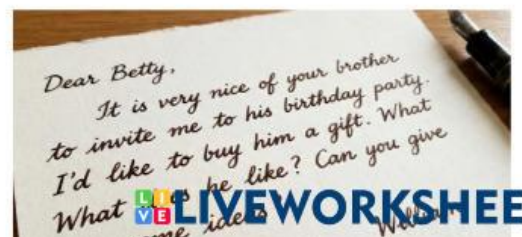

Natural disasters like floods, hurricanes, and wildfires have always been part of life on Earth. However, scientists say these events are becoming more frequent and severe. Climate change is making our planet warmer, and this is changing weather patterns around the world.

When temperatures rise, more water evaporates from oceans and lakes. This creates stronger storms with heavier rainfall. In some areas, these storms cause terrible floods that destroy homes and farms. At the same time, other regions experience long periods without rain, leading to droughts. These dry conditions make it easier for wildfires to start and spread quickly.

The effects of natural disasters are **devastating** for communities. People lose their homes, jobs, and sometimes their lives. Poor countries suffer the most because they lack the money and technology to prepare for disasters or rebuild afterwards. Entire villages can be destroyed in just a few hours, and it may take years for people to recover.

Experts believe we must act now to reduce the impact of future disasters. This means cutting carbon emissions to slow down climate change. It also means building stronger infrastructure, creating early warning systems, and helping communities **bolster** their preparedness for emergencies. While we cannot stop all natural disasters, we can reduce the damage they cause.
