Hanoi's Old Quarter is a special place that shows the rich history of Vietnam's capital city. This area has existed for nearly 1,000 years and was once the heart of trade and craft in the city. Each street was named after the product sold there, like Hang Bac (Silver Street) or Hang Gao (Rice Street).

In the past, the Old Quarter was a **bustling** center of commerce. Craftsmen and traders lived and worked in narrow tube houses. These special buildings were long and thin because people paid taxes based on the width of their street-facing walls. Families passed down their trades from generation to generation. The streets were always full of vendors, customers, and the sounds of traditional crafts being made.

Today, the Old Quarter still keeps much of its traditional character, but many things have changed. Modern shops, cafes, and hotels now stand beside old craft workshops. Motorbikes fill the streets where bicycles once ruled. Tourism has brought new life to the area, but it has also created challenges like traffic jams and noise.

Despite these changes, local people and the government work hard to **retain** the Old Quarter's unique identity. They protect old buildings, support traditional crafts, and maintain the special atmosphere that makes this place different from anywhere else in the world. The Old Quarter remains a living museum where past and present exist together.
