## Expressing necessity/ lack of necessity

**MUST / HAVE TO / NEED** – to express necessity  
*We have to hurry or we'll miss the plane.  
The lawn needs cutting.*

**DON'T NEED TO / DON'T HAVE TO / NEEDN'T** – to express lack of necessity (present)  
*She doesn't need to work, her husband is well-off.  
You needn't tell Jill, I've already phoned her.*

**DIDN'T NEED TO / DIDN'T HAVE TO** – to express lack of necessity (past)  
*She didn't need to cook as they went out for dinner.  
They didn't have to call an ambulance, nobody was injured.*
