8. Andrew: "How is your journey?"

**Indirect:** Jane asked if I liked \_\_\_\_\_ hat.
- Direct:** "I will put the boxes **here**," the worker said.  
**Indirect:** The worker said he would put the boxes \_\_\_\_\_.
- Direct:** "Look at **these** flowers," said my mother.  
**Indirect:** My mother told me to look at \_\_\_\_\_ flowers.
- Direct:** "I've lived in **this** house for years," he told me.  
**Indirect:** He told me that he had lived in \_\_\_\_\_ house for years.
- Direct:** "Are **these** your keys?" the officer asked.  
**Indirect:** The officer asked if \_\_\_\_\_ were my keys.
- Direct:** "Is there a bank near **here**?" the traveler asked.  
**Indirect:** The traveler asked if there was a bank near \_\_\_\_\_.
- Direct:** "I can't carry all **these** bags," she said.  
**Indirect:** She said she couldn't carry all \_\_\_\_\_ bags.
- Direct:** "We can meet **here** tomorrow," they said.  
**Indirect:** They said they could meet \_\_\_\_\_ the next day.
- Direct:** "Who left **this** umbrella on the floor?" the teacher asked.  
**Indirect:** The teacher asked who had left \_\_\_\_\_ umbrella on the floor.
