FURTHER PRACTICE

1) Turn from Active into Passive Voice.

a. Someone is helping her with the housework.

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b. A pickpocket robbed me.

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c. You must extinguish your cigarettes.

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d. You must dry-clean this shirt.

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e. Someone will pay you within the next few days.

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f. You can improve your health with more exercise.

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g. A dog is chasing the child.

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h. Someone has broken our door down.

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i. They chose him as the best actor of the year.

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j. I have to return these books to the library.

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2) Turn from Active into Passive as in the example:

a. He gave a present. → *I was given a present.* Or *A present was given to me.*

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c. The Queen presented him with a medal.

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d. Her mother bought Mary some sweets.

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e. Bob has sold Ted a second-hand car.

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f. Larry is going to send an email to Tom.

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g. I sent Anne some roses.

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h. The secretary has given Mrs Jones some letters.

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i. My friend sent me an invitation.

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j. The mail-order company sent Mr Green a parcel.

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
