

1.2 Present Simple.

Positive and negative sentences

- We use Present Simple to talk about routines and habits.

+	I / You / We / They like reading books.	He / She / It likes reading books.
-	I / You / We / They don't like playing football.	He / She / It doesn't like playing football.
?	Do I / you / we / they like reading books?	Does he / she / it like reading books?

Remember! Spelling Rules:

general rule -s	verbs ending in - o, sh, tch, s, x -es	verbs ending in consonants + y -ies
work - works	brush - brushes	study - studies
eat - eats	go - goes	try - tries
play - plays	kiss - kisses	cry - cries
swim - swims	watch - watches	fly - flies
walk - walks	mix - mixes	spy - spies

Remember **have - has**
