The **Past Simple** is used to talk about completed actions that happened at a specific time in the past.

- For **regular verbs**, we usually add **-ed** (e.g., *walked*).
- For **irregular verbs**, the form changes (e.g., *go* becomes *went*).
- For **negatives** and **questions**, we use the auxiliary verb **did** + the base form of the main verb.
