

Intonation Worksheet (Rising ↗ / Falling ↘)

Objective: Identify and classify rising and falling intonation using the same audio.

Brief Explanation

Rising intonation (↗) is used in yes/no questions. Falling intonation (↘) is used in statements and WH-questions.

Audio Script

1. Are you ready?
2. Where do you live?
3. Do you like coffee?
4. What is your name?
5. Is she your friend?
6. Why are you late?
7. Can you help me?
8. Where is the station?
