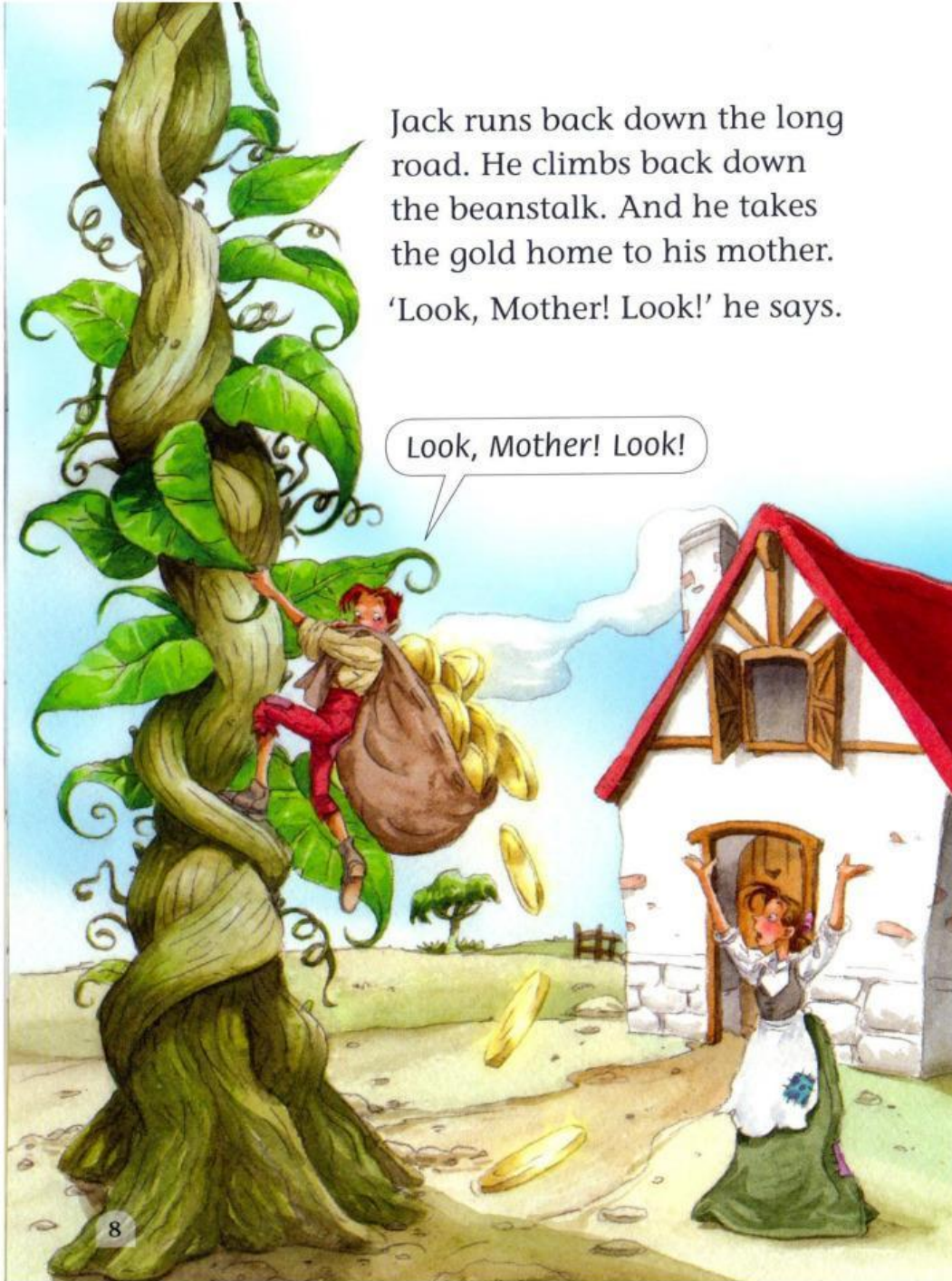


Jack runs back down the long road. He climbs back down the beanstalk. And he takes the gold home to his mother. 'Look, Mother! Look!' he says.
