### Affirmative (+)

He is sleeping.  
She is sleeping.  
It is sleeping.  
You are sleeping.  
We are sleeping.  
They are sleeping.

### Negative (-)

I am not sleeping.  
He isn't sleeping.  
She isn't sleeping.  
It isn't sleeping.  
You aren't sleeping.  
We aren't sleeping.  
They aren't sleeping.

### Interrogative (?)

Am I sleeping?  
Is he sleeping?  
Is she sleeping?  
Is it sleeping?  
Are you sleeping?  
Are we sleeping?  
Are they sleeping?

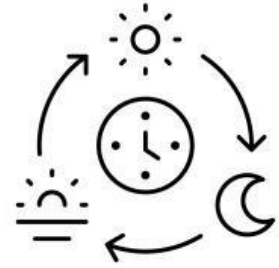
