Singular and Plural

When we change a noun from singular (one) to plural (more than one), we follow these rules:

1. Nouns

We add (s) at the end of the word.

We remove a / an / one.

Example:

a pen → pens

one book → books

2. Sentences (There is / There are)

We change:

There is → for singular

There are → for plural

Example:

There is a ball → There are balls
