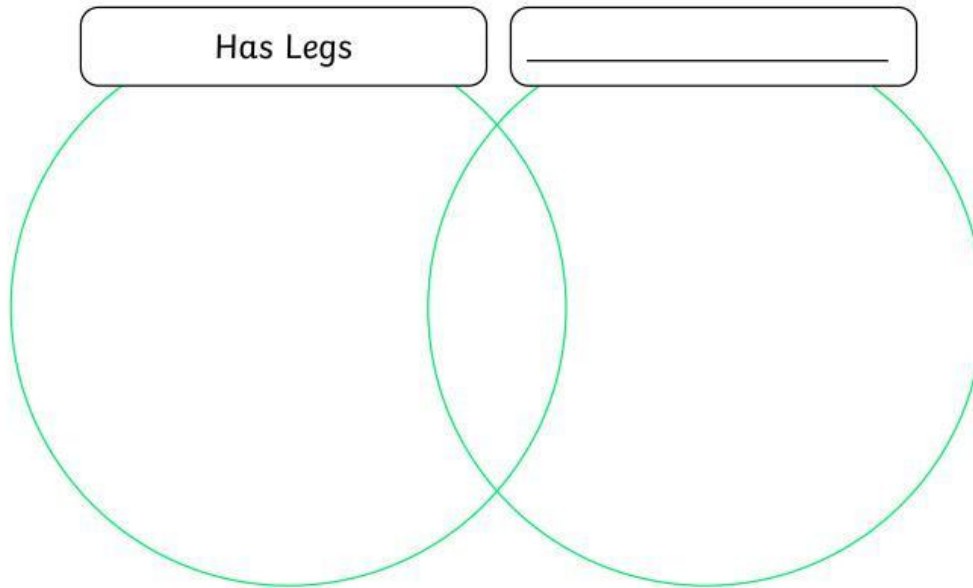


Venn and Carroll Diagrams
