

FREQUENCY ADVERBS



Frequency adverbs help us describe how often an action occurs, or how many times the action has occurred.

Most common: always, usually, often, sometimes, hardly ever, never.

Frequency



Adverbs

always
usually
often
sometimes
hardly ever
never

Examples

She **always** brushes her teeth after lunch
He **usually** drinks coffee in the morning
They **often** read books
We **sometimes** wake up late
He **hardly ever** gets angry
I am **never** late
