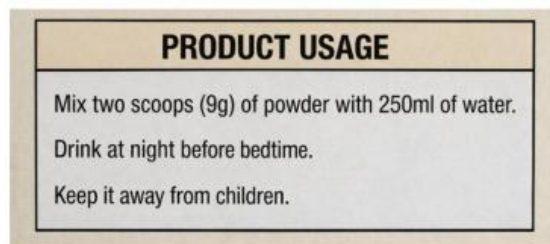

When the Water Comes

Every year, when the rainy season comes to central Vietnam, many families start watching the sky. They check the water level of the nearby river. They move their things to higher shelves. For people living in these areas, this is not scary. It is just a normal part of life. Floods have come to these villages for many generations, and people have learned to live with them. But in recent years, something has changed. The floods come more often, arrive faster, and cause more damage than before.

Scientists say that climate change is making bad weather more **frequent** all over the world. In Vietnam, this means stronger storms and heavier rain in a shorter time. Farmers who used to know exactly when to plant their crops now find that the old ways no longer work. Families who built their homes far from the river are finding that they are not safe anymore. The things that communities depended on for hundreds of years are slowly changing.

But people are not just waiting for things to get worse. In many villages, young people are working with local leaders to plant more trees, make riverbanks stronger, and warn their neighbours when danger is coming. This kind of community action is often small and quiet, but it can be very **resilient**. A disaster does not only show how easily things can break. Sometimes it shows how much people are ready to do for each other when it really matters.
