The Dazzling Da Nang International Fireworks Festival (DIFF)

The Da Nang International Fireworks Festival (DIFF) is much more than just a fireworks show; it is a spectacular competition to find the best team and cultural event that transforms Vietnam's central coast city into a vibrant 'Festival City'. Held every year over the Han River, the event attracts many visitors, making Da Nang an important tourist place in Asia.

What started as a smaller competition has grown into a major global show. The festival usually includes eight international teams, plus the team from Vietnam, who compete strongly for the top prize. Each night has a specific

subject or theme, and teams make their long firework displays (about 20-22 minutes) match the music perfectly, creating a memorable experience. The fireworks are launched from the east side of the Han River, lighting up the city's famous bridges and skyline.

While the main area (grandstand) on the west side of the Han River offers the best view (and tickets), the festival's lively feeling spreads all over the city.

- River Cruises: Many visitors choose to watch the fireworks from a boat on the Han River, which often includes a meal and a city tour.
- High-Rise Views: Tall buildings and hotels near the river offer excellent views, sometimes selling special tickets to their rooftop viewing areas.
- Free Spots: For people who prefer to save money, areas near the river, like public parks, allow you to enjoy the show for free.
