\_\_\_\_\_ - tells where your story happen

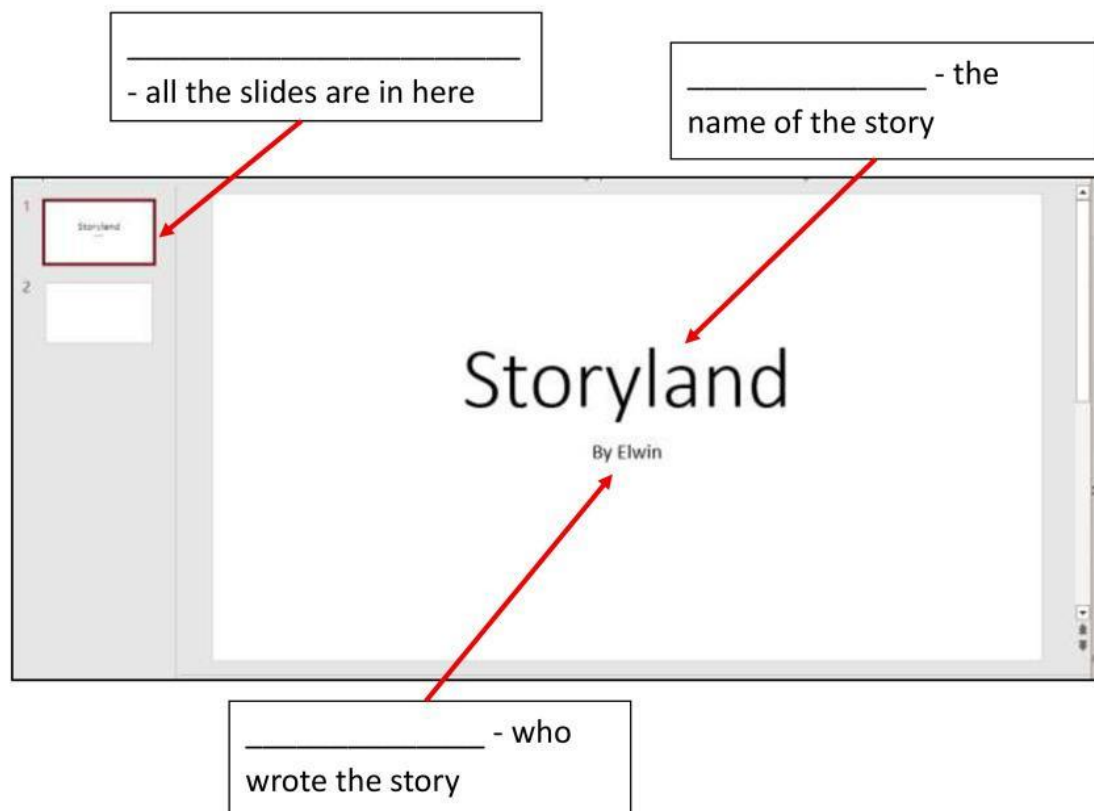
\_\_\_\_\_ - an issue which needs to be solved
