THE IMPORTANT CULTURAL VALUE OF TRADITIONAL TẾT DISHES

Tết, Vietnam's most important holiday, is a time for families to reunite and welcome the Lunar New Year. Traditional Tết dishes hold great cultural and spiritual value, symbolizing respect for ancestors and good wishes for the new year. These dishes include bánh chưng (square cake), boiled chicken, spring rolls, pickled onions, and bamboo soup.

Elderly Hanoian Trương Thị Hội shares that Tết trays not only bring families together but also reflect Vietnam's cultural identity. Bánh chưng, a dish made from sticky rice, green beans, and pork, is considered **sacred** and represents the universe. **It** provides energy for winter days and was created thousands of years ago to show gratitude to heaven, earth, and family.

Boiled chicken, another key dish, is carefully cooked to retain its flavor and symbolize strength and integrity. Pickled onions are served alongside bánh chưng to improve digestion and **enhance** flavor.

For overseas Vietnamese like Nguyễn Thị Sương, these dishes connect them to their roots. Living in Germany, she misses her family's Tết tray, particularly bánh chưng and pickled onions. She hopes to reunite with loved ones soon to celebrate Tết with traditional meals that preserve Vietnam's rich cultural heritage.
