

# BE CREATIVE!



Reduction of Relative clauses

1. With verb to be

Don't forget to take out WHO and the verb to be ---and use the rest of the idea

## Examples

Someone **WHO IS** resourceful is considered as creative

*Reduce version:* Someone **resourceful** is considered as creative



Reduction of Relative clauses

2. With a verb

Don't forget to hake out WHO --- and use the verb with ING and the rest of the idea

## Examples

A person **WHO use** imagination could be considered as creative

*Reduce version:* A person **USING** imagination could be considered as creative

Reduction of Relative clauses

3. With have/ has

Don't forget to take out WHO and the verb have --- use with and the rest of the idea

## Examples

A person **WHO has** a great voice is considered as creative

Reduce version: A person **WITH** a great voice is considered as creative
