I have the uncomfortable feeling that I can't concentrate the way I used to some time ago. I have noticed that my lack of concentration starts, particularly, when I attempt to focus my attention on a novel or an essay. Going back to the text becomes a challenge. This might be because I've increased the amount of time in front of a screen searching for information on the internet in the past months.

Clive Thompson suggests that Google is an extension of the mind. This search engine, he says, has a positive effect on our thinking abilities. After all, thanks to Google we have access to almost anything. However unexpected effects may result from this situation. In the 1960's Marshall McLuhan suggested that technology would provide knowledge to everyone, and that's what is happening nowadays. Online media not only produces contents but it also controls the process of thought, making our mind jump from one thought to another so quickly that we don't even notice.

A recent study of internet search habits indicated that internet users often glance at headlines and list of contents. They succeed in getting what they need in a short time. They may well be getting much more knowledge and reliable information than ever before, but in the process, several important skills like memory may become less reliable. I fully agree with these conclusions.

Maybe I'm just a negative person. However, just as there are supporters of technological progress, there are also people who refuse to accept it. Socrates, for example, believed that writing didn't serve to promote the development of new ideas. Only time will prove me right or wrong.
