



Productive Skills Test for Intermediate Level Speaking Test



Objectives:

- Given a series of words and sentences read aloud by the teacher, intermediate students will be able to accurately repeat the stimuli with correct pronunciation, stress, and intonation in at least 80% of the items.
- After listening to short sentences, intermediate learners will be able to imitate the rhythm and intonation patterns producing intelligible speech with minimal pronunciation errors in 5 out of 10 attempts.

Evaluated Skills:

- Produce English stress patterns, words in stressed and unstressed positions, rhythmic structure, and intonation contours.
- Produce reduced forms of words and phrases.
- Produce chunks of language of different lengths.
- Produce fluent speech at different rates of delivery.
