

# COUNTABLE AND UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS

REMEMBER: We use THERE IS for singular and uncountable nouns (sustantivos incontables)

Example: There is a player in the stadium.

We use THERE ARE for plural nouns (sustantivos plurales)

Example: There are many fans outside.

## Countable Nouns

Son sustantivos que se pueden contar individualmente. Para ello we can use: numbers, a/an, many, some, a lot of y tienen singular y plural.

Examples: player / players, fan / fans, goal / goals, sandwich / sandwiches

Ejemplos: There are three players, there are some Boca fans.

There is A LOT OF noise in La Bombonera.
