The To Lich River is one of the most well-known rivers in Hanoi, but sadly, it is also one of the most polluted. A long time ago, people used to enjoy walking along the river, watching the clear water flow. Now, when you pass by, all you see is black water and garbage floating on the surface. The smell is strong and **unpleasant**, and many people feel sorry that the river has become this way.

There are many reasons why the To Lich River is polluted. Wastewater from homes and factories is often poured directly into the river without being treated.
