Representatives from 175 countries met in Busan, South Korea, to discuss a plan to reduce plastic pollution. The meeting, organized by the U.N. Intergovernmental Negotiating Committee (INC-5), aimed to create international rules for managing plastic waste. The committee chair, Luis Vayas Valdivieso, shared ideas like making a list of plastic products to control and providing financial help for poorer countries. However, some important issues, like setting limits on plastic production, were left undecided.

Countries that face serious problems from plastic pollution, such as low- and middle-income nations, asked for stronger action. They wanted **clear targets** to reduce the production of new plastics. On the other hand, countries like Saudi Arabia, which produce petrochemicals, did not agree. They preferred focusing on recycling rather than cutting production.

Critics said that just recycling is not enough and that reducing production is necessary to stop pollution at its source. Some delegates were unhappy with the slow progress of the talks. Over 100 countries supported a proposal to include plastic reduction targets, but finding agreement was difficult.

Despite these disagreements, many participants agreed that creating a system where plastics are reused and recycled could help the environment. If successful, this **treaty** could set an example for the world in the fight against plastic pollution.
