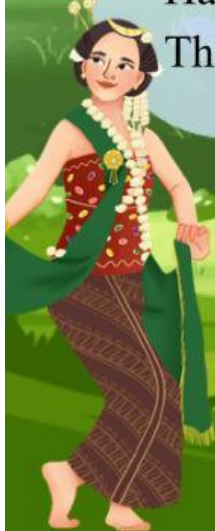

★ Good writers follow steps! ☆



STEP 1: PLAN

Use your answers from the warm-up.

Organize your ideas into:



Orientation



Events



Reorientation



STEP 2: DRAFT

Write your first version.

Remember:

- ✓ Use past tense (played, joined, won, saw)
- ✓ Use time connectives (first, then, after that, next, finally)
- ✓ Follow the structure Orientation – Events – Reorientation



STEP 3: REVISE

Check your writing:

- Did you write orientation?
- Did you write at least 5 events?
- Did you use past tense verbs?
- Did you use time connectives?
- Did you write your feeling at the end?

1. ABOUT RECOUNT TEXT

Word	Meaning
recount text	a text that tells about past events
orientation	the beginning part (who, when, where)
event	something that happened
reorientation	the ending part (your feeling or comment)
sequence	the order of events



2. GRAMMAR WORDS

Word	Meaning
past tense	verb form used for past actions
regular verb	verb that adds -ed (played, joined)
irregular verb	verb that changes form (went, saw, won)
negative sentence	sentence using "did not"
question form	sentence starting with "Did...?"
