

SPEAKING LESSON: LOST IN THE CITY

- Have you ever helped a tourist in your city?
- What do tourists usually ask about here?
- What's the most famous place tourists want to see?

TASK 1: Read the dialogue and choose: True (T), False (F), Not Stated (NS).

Tourist: Excuse me, I think I'm lost. Is there a metro station near here?
Stranger: A metro station? Which line do you need?
Tourist: I don't know... I need the city center. I have a map but it's in my phone, and my phone is dead.
Stranger: Oh no. Okay, don't panic. Do you remember any building near your hotel?
Tourist: Maybe... a big yellow church? And a coffee shop called "Coffee like in Paris"?
Stranger: (laughs) That's funny. Actually, I know that place. You are not lost. You are 5 minutes from the center. Just go straight, then turn left at the pharmacy.
Tourist: Really? Thank you! You saved my day.
Stranger: No problem. And maybe buy a power bank for your phone.
Tourist: Good idea. Thanks again!
