ANCIENT EMPIRES



KINGDOM OF AKSUM

(East Asia)

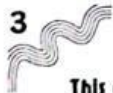
This empire was in what is now Ethiopia. It was rich from trade and used its own written language. It built tall stone towers called stelae.



HITTITE EMPIRE

(Asia Minor)

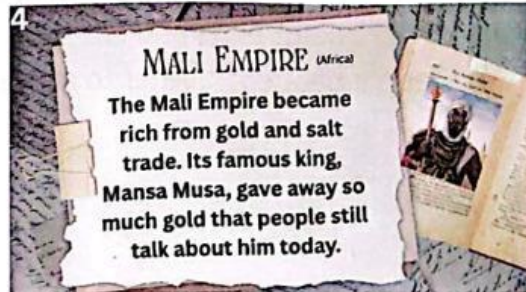
The Hittites lived in what is now Turkey. They were the first people to make tools and weapons from iron. They also made peace treaties.



Khmer Empire

(Southeast Asia)

This empire was in present-day Cambodia. It built huge temples like Angkor Wat and had an advanced water system for farming.



MALI EMPIRE

(African)

The Mali Empire became rich from gold and salt trade. Its famous king, Mansa Musa, gave away so much gold that people still talk about him today.



5 SCYTHIAN EMPIRE

(Central Asia)

The Scythians were expert horse riders and archers. They lived in tents, moved often, and were buried with gold and weapons.



Silla Kingdom

(South Korea)

Silla was one of the early Korean kingdoms. It united much of Korea and built beautiful gold crowns and temples.



7 Zapotec Empire

(Mexico)

The Zapotec people lived before the Aztecs. They made their own writing and built cities with pyramids in the mountains.



8 Srivijaya Empire

(Indonesia)

This empire controlled sea trade in Southeast Asia. It was known for ships, learning, and spreading Buddhism across the islands.
