EUROPEAN TRANSPORT SYSTEMS

Transport systems are a vital part of modern life in Europe. They allow people to move from place to place easily and enable companies to deliver goods across long distances. Europe has one of the most developed transport networks in the world, including trains, buses, cars, ships, and planes. However, these systems face several challenges, especially with environmental pollution and traffic problems in cities.

Many European countries are working hard to improve their transport systems in ways that are better for the planet. One important solution is encouraging people to use public transport instead of driving their own cars.
