

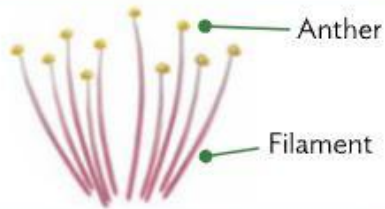


The flower is the organ where both the male and female gametes of angiosperms are produced. The seeds are also formed in the flower. Flowers contain various parts, but some do not contain all of them.

Corolla. Formed of the **petals**. These usually have bright colours.

Chalice. Formed of a group of green leaves called **sepals**.

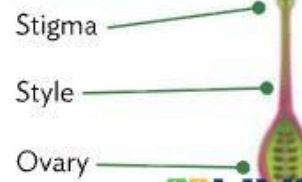
The **stamens** produce **pollen** grains. These contain the male gametes.



Pistil. This produces the female gametes.

Stamens. These produce the male gametes.

Peduncle. This joins the flower to the stem.



The **pistil** produces **ovules**. These contain the female gametes.
