1. Form and Function 🐾

Animals possess unique physical adaptations that allow them to thrive in their specific environments. **Word bank: tail, fur, beak, scales**

Task: Identify the primary body feature shown for each animal. Then, explain the **purpose** of that feature (how it helps the animal eat, move, or survive).

2. Ask the Expert ?

Answer: **No, she doesn't.**

3. Write a question about her skin or texture:

Answer: **Yes, she does.**

4. Write a question that compares her to a bird:

Answer: **No, she doesn't.**
