Part A: Grammar — Imperative Sentences

Imperative sentences give commands or directions. Start with the verb. Do not use I, you, he, she.

✓ Correct (Imperative)

*Turn left at the traffic light.
Go two blocks.
Cross Main Street.*

✗ Incorrect (not imperative)

*You turn left at the traffic light.
I go two blocks.
She crosses Main Street.*

Study these imperative verbs for driving directions.

Verb (base form)	Where / How	Full sentence
Go	straight ahead.	<i>Go straight ahead.</i>
Turn	left / right.	<i>Turn left at the traffic light.</i>
Cross	the street.	<i>Cross Main Street.</i>
Stop	at the corner.	<i>Stop at the stop sign.</i>
Make	a U-turn.	<i>Make a U-turn here.</i>
Stay	in your lane.	<i>Stay in your lane on the highway.</i>
Park	next to the curb.	<i>Park next to the curb.</i>
Take	the highway.	<i>Take the highway to exit 5.</i>
