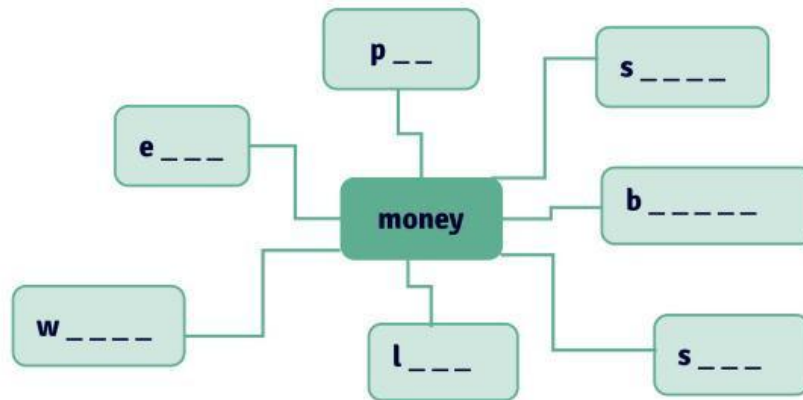

PRONUNCIATION TIP

The schwa /ə/ is the most common sound in English. It is a short, unstressed vowel sound that is in words like *banana*, *about* and *mother*. It can be used with any vowel letter but always sounds the same: a quick, neutral "uh". Here are some examples using different vowel letters: *sofa*, *seven*, *family*, *lemon*, *support*.
