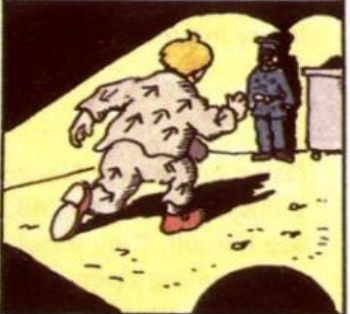

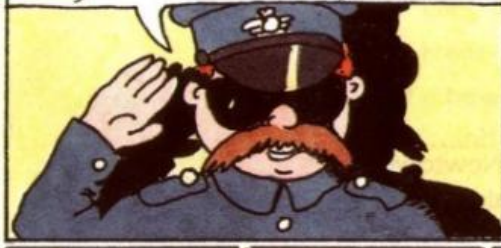
LADY PRESCOTT GOT OF THE CAR AND LOOKED THERE WAS NO ONE ELSE



FREDERICK SLIPPED OF THE CAR AND RAN THE ALLEY.



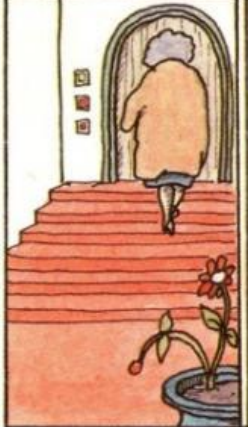
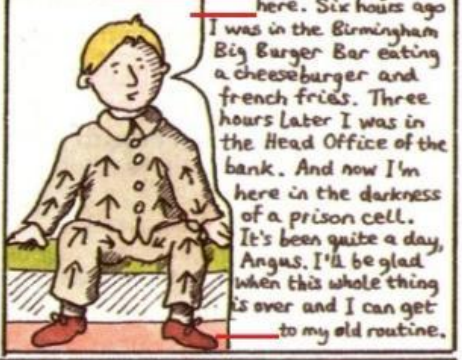
Welcome back Sir. I'm so glad to see you again. I thought I was going to lose my job when you disappeared. I shouldn't have nodded - you see. It was all my fault.
