| Happy     | Feliz / Contento     | A united family spending time together.          |
| Sad       | Triste               | A little girl when she cannot play outside.      |
| Upset     | Molesto / Indignado  | A student who fails an important exam.           |
| Excited   | Emocionado           | A boy who wins a big competition.                |
| Afraid    | Asustado / Con miedo | A person who is terrified of a dog.              |
| Angry     | Enojado / Enfadado   | Feeling intense irritation or displeasure.       |
| Bored     | Aburrido             | Having nothing interesting or fun to do.         |
| Tired     | Cansado              | How a woman feels after working hard all day.    |
| Surprised | Sorprendido          | Receiving an unexpected and nice present.        |
| Nervous   | Nervioso             | Speaking in public or before an important event. |
| Proud     | Orgullosa            | A runner who successfully wins a race.           |
| Sick      | Enfermo              | When you don't feel okay and need to rest.       |
