## Affirmative & Negative forms

### Grammar Review: Have got / Has got

Affirmative	Negative
I <b>have got</b>	I <b>haven't got</b>
You <b>have got</b>	You <b>haven't got</b>
He <b>has got</b>	He <b>hasn't got</b>
She <b>has got</b>	She <b>hasn't got</b>
It <b>has got</b>	It <b>hasn't got</b>
We <b>have got</b>	We <b>haven't got</b>
You <b>have got</b>	You <b>haven't got</b>
They <b>have got</b>	They <b>haven't got</b>
