She wore a long dress and a coat, and she only had a small bag with her. First she went from New Jersey (USA) to Southampton (UK) by boat. She was very ill while she was at sea. From England, she went to France, and she visited Jules Verne, a famous writer. She travelled through many countries, including Italy, Egypt and Hong Kong, and then she went to Japan. She loved the beautiful traditional clothes there. Nelly's journey was very long: she had to cross the Pacific Ocean, and she was on a boat for two weeks. She arrived in San Francisco on January 21. The director of the newspaper paid for a private train to take her back to New Jersey. She arrived there on January 25, 1890 after travelling for 72 days. Nelly Bly was the first woman - and the fastest person then - to travel around the world.
