Mark Zuckerberg, the CEO of Facebook, has announced a new policy which will ban advertisements claiming that minorities, immigrants, racial or other groups are a threat, as part of a wider effort to **restrict** hate speech.

"Specifically, we're expanding our ads policy to prohibit claims that people from a specific race, ethnicity, national origin, religious affiliation, caste, sexual orientation, gender identity or immigration status are a threat to the physical safety, health or survival of others," Zuckerberg wrote in a recent post. "We're also expanding our policies to better protect immigrants, migrants, refugees and asylum seekers from ads suggesting these groups are inferior or expressing contempt, dismissal or disgust directed at **them**."
