





Hi Fahed,

I hope you're doing great! Recently, I have finished reading a book about Thomas Edison, and he is so interesting that I just had to tell you about him. You've probably heard his name in science class, but he was one of the greatest inventors of all times.

Edison came from a really interesting family. He was born in 1847 in Ohio, the youngest of seven children! His father, Samuel Edison, was a restless man who had many different jobs. His mother, Nancy Elliott, was a former school teacher, which was lucky for Thomas. His childhood was actually pretty tough because he was always getting into trouble. As a kid, he was always getting into trouble because he was so curious and couldn't sit still in class. His teachers thought he was a slow learner. When his school teacher called him "addled" (which basically meant he was considered as a slow learner), his mom got so upset that she pulled him out of school. She believed in him more than anyone else and taught him everything she knew at home. He also lost most of his hearing as a kid, but he called it a blessing because it helped him focus on his work without being distracted by noise.

He ended up becoming a world-famous inventor with over 1,000 patents. While everyone knows him for the light bulb, he actually just made it better so it could stay on for a long time. He also created the phonograph, which was the first machine that could record music, and he even helped build the first cameras for movies. Later in life, he had his own family with six children. He even nicknamed his first two kids "Dot" and "Dash" after Morse code!

The coolest thing about Edison was that he failed thousands of times while trying to make his inventions work, but he never gave up. I thought that was a great lesson for us to never give up and keep learning!
