

London

: This city is famous for its changeable weather. In autumn and winter, it can be rainy, cloudy and even snowy, but not often. The citizens are used to foggy mornings, especially along the River Thames. It doesn't snow often, but when it does, it often leads a lot of problems in the transport system. Spring is usually sunny, and summer is nice and warm. There are some hot days in summer but not so many. The climat is nice and mild here.

MOSCOW

: The climat in this city is continental with well-defined seasons. Winters are long, cold, and snowy, with temperatures often below zero. Snow covers the city from November to March. Summers are short but warm and sunny, there are also some hot days, but not so many of them. Spring and autumn mark transitional periods with changeable weather. The city can also encounter thunderstorms during the summer and spring months.

Bangkok

: This capital has a tropical climate. It is known for being hot and rainy throughout the year. The city experiences two seasons: the wet season and the dry season. The wet season, from May to October, is characterised by heavy rain and floods. The dry season, from November to April, is hot, sunny and rather dry. It never snows here and the temperature is always around 30-36 degrees.
