

Connectives

These words join ideas, clauses, or sentences together to show relationships:

- **and:** Adds information. I love chocolate *and* ice cream.
- **but:** Shows contrast. I love chocolate ice cream *but* I don't eat them very often.
- **because:** Explains a reason. I love chocolate ice cream *because* it is so creamy.
- **so (that):** Expresses a result or purpose. I love chocolate *so* I enjoy it very much.
- **(in order) to + verb:** Indicates a specific goal or intention.
I always go to the store *in order to* buy chocolate ice cream.

Wh- question words

These are used to request specific information. Common examples include:

- Who (person) : *Who is the guy over there?*
- What (thing/action) *What time is it?*
- Where (place) *Where did you go last night?*
- When (time) *When are you coming to Monterrey?*
- Why (reason) *Why is she taking all that money?*
- How (manner/method) *How was the party?*
