1. Quick Explanation

We use the **Present Simple** to talk about:

- Routines and habits → *I go to school every day.*
- Facts → *Dogs like bones.*
- Things that are generally true → *The sun rises in the east.*

Subject-Verb Concord

Look carefully at the subject:

Normal verb		Super S	
I	play	He	plays
You	play	She	plays
We	play	It	plays
They	play		

★ **REMEMBER:** With **he, she, it**, we usually add **-s** to the verb.

Negative Form

Use **don't** or **doesn't** + base verb.

- I **don't like** coffee.
- They **don't play** tennis.
- She **doesn't like** coffee.
- He **doesn't play** tennis.

★ After **doesn't**, the verb has **NO -s**.

Questions

Use **Do** or **Does** + subject + base verb.

- **Do** you like music?
- **Do** they study English?
- **Does** she like music?
- **Does** he study English?

★ After **does**, the verb has **NO -s**.
