



There was a waterfall.	There wasn't a bridge.
There were some rocks.	There weren't any cars.
Was there a forest?	Yes, there was . No, there wasn't .
Were there any birds?	Yes, there were . No, there weren't .



Look! We use *a lot of* and *some* with *There were*. We use *any* with *There weren't*.

1) Select all the SOME, ANY and A LOT OF.

2) Listen and select.



1. There **weren't any** / **were some** cars.
2. There **were some** / **lots of** colourful birds.
3. There **were some** / **lots of** tables.
4. There **was** / **wasn't** a bridge.
5. There **was** / **wasn't** a big waterfall.
6. There **were some** / **weren't any** big rocks.
