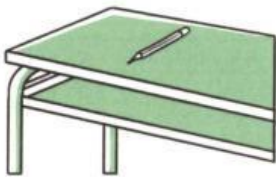

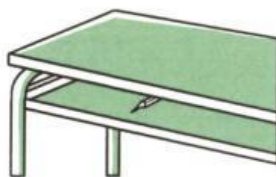

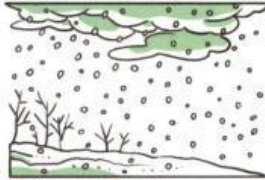

Phase 1

Back-up prompts

If the candidate doesn't understand or answer the question, the interlocutor will ask a similar question using different words:

- Are you from *(country)*?
- Do you live in *(name of the area, town, etc.)*?

Phase 2

Interlocutor

Now let's talk about TV.

(Candidate A), what types of TV programmes do you like watching?
What types of TV programmes do you not like? Why?

(Candidate B), what types of TV programmes do you usually watch with
your family?

Where do you watch your favourite programmes? On TV? On a tablet?

(Candidate A), tell me something about your favourite TV programme.

Now let's talk about weekends.

(Candidate A), what do you usually do at the weekend?
Do you often play outdoors?

(Candidate B), how often do you play outdoors at the weekend?
What do you usually do?

(Candidate B), tell me something about the weekend activities in your
neighbourhood.

Back-up prompts

- Do you like TV series?
- Have you got a TV in your bedroom?
- Do you ever watch TV on your smartphone?
- Do you watch TV with your friends?
- Do you watch films at school?
- Do you get up late at weekends?
- Do you have lunch at some relative's place at weekends?
- Do you have homework to do at the weekend?
- Do you often travel with your family at the weekend?

Part 2 (5 - 6 minutes)*Phase 1 (3-4 minutes)*

Interlocutor Now in this part you're going to talk together.
