### Topic: Verbs Followed By Gerund or Infinitive With Different Meanings

#### Exercise 1:

**Instructions:** Read the sentences carefully and choose the correct option (Gerund or Infinitive) depending on the meaning of the verb.

## Speaking Extension

### Teacher's Guide:

- **Target Audience:** Students of B1 Level (Intermediate).
- **Objective:** To distinguish the subtle change of meaning in verbs followed by gerunds or infinitives (*stop, remember, forget, try, regret*).
- **Methodology:** 1. **Presentation:** Explicitly explain on the board the difference between actions in the past (gerund) and duties/purposes (infinitive). 2. **Practice:** Students complete Exercises 1, 2, and 3 individually or in pairs. 3. **Production:** Students perform the productive writing/speaking activity to internalize the structures.
